- \rightarrow 2012 = 76% NZ NP's (n76 of 100)
- \triangleright 2014 = 70% NZ NP's (n91 of 129)
- Capture employment, geographical spread, role & practice habits
- Track development of practice & scopes in response to reduction of barriers to practice





NB. Areas matched to NZNC regions

We want to work as NPs & are willing to move for role.


















IN 2012 64% daily basis 93% of NPs ordering labs

= growth in community labs use








What types of laboratory investigations do you order?



- ▶ **Blood** biochem 100.0%
- haematology 97.8% hormone/ endocrine 67.4%
 other (eg PSA/ ANA/TGG) 53.9%
 immunology 52.8%
 - Microbiology urine 89.9% swabs 84.3% faecal 58.4% other (body fluids/sputum) 59.6%
 - Cytology smears 36.0% FOB 28.1% Cytology urine 25.8% Histology 22.5% Other (please specify) 15.7%

NPNZ survey 2012 & 2014 Q15 = 100% increase in daily ordering radiology for pts by NPs = greater access to radiology for pts







What sort of Radiology investigations do you order?

















2012= partial 57%, fully 32% 2014=partial 62%, fully 26%

53% NPs had non clinical hours from 2-40 hrs/ wk







