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## Majority of knee and hip joint replacements last longer than 25 years

Two recent cohort studies were published on the longevity of hip<sup>1</sup> and knee joint<sup>2</sup> replacements.

For hip joint replacements, 58% lasted longer than 25 years. For total knee joint replacements, 82% lasted longer than 25 years. For unicondylar knee joint replacements, 70% lasted longer than 25 years.
