

# Change to Cervical Screening Start Age: Primary Care/PHO Update December 2019

### **Primary Care Practice Management System (PMS) changes**

The implementation of the age change is as detailed below:

- Women under 25 years of age who are not currently in the programme are *no longer invited for screening.*
- Women under 25 who have already been screened, should continue to be screened according to the current pathway.

For clarification, as noted in our earlier communications, there is an exception to this guidance:

- Women that have already received an invitation from their provider to start screening but have no screening record remain on the recall list.
- Screening providers should discuss the programme change with women who are under 25 and have already been invited. The Ministry would recommend that these women be recalled for screening at 25 years, unless there is a clinical rationale for someone to commence screening earlier.
